## **UKRAINIAN MISSIONARY UPDATE**

Listed below is an update Kim Smith received from Roman, Ukrainian Missionary:

This summer has been busy. We had “wounded warriors” camp for the guys who were injured on the east of Ukraine and their families. And then, I’ve been heavily involved in two large English school projects in Rivne and Lutsk. In each of the cities we had about 1,000 students. In Lutsk, we had 300 kids and 700 adults. Over 300 people from adult sessions positively responded to the invitation to become followers of Jesus Christ. Please pray for the follow-up work with these people.

Please, continue to pray for my ministry. I’ll be starting a three-month English course with a group of teachers from my church in September. This will be for those who attended our summer school. We already have almost 200 people signed up who are willing to study English and Bible at our course. We are praying the Lord helps us to build close relationships with these people and welcome them in our home churches and help them to follow Jesus Christ. Later this month, I’m leaving to go to a youth camp. We’ll have about 30 new young people there who don’t know Jesus yet. I’ll be explaining Gospel to them and inviting them to follow the Lord. Please pray for me as I prepare and conduct the Word for them.

I want to let you know my home church and I are praying for TBC and those of you that travel to Ukraine that have family health issues that prevent you coming to Ukraine this year. May the Lord lead each of you through it, comfort and support you with His mighty hand. Please send my heartfelt greetings to everyone who knows me at TBC. We will really miss you all this year. Praying the Lord will allow us to work together in 2017.
