

NONFINANCIAL MISSION SUPPORT

For more than 15 years, Tabernacle has been supporting local and mission projects with nonfinancial items given by members. However, some of those items can no longer be collected while others are still needed.

We still accept clothing for Goodwill which may be placed in the box in the basement below the middle stairway. For each box the church receives the ability to help clothe other individuals who come to us for help. Eyeglasses are still collected by the Lions Club, and there is a box in the coatroom near the elevator where you may put them. The Box Tops for Education, which assist a native American mission school in Arizona, may still be put in the mission basket next to the Lions Club basket in the coatroom.

On August 1st this year Campbell's ended their soup label campaign which we used to assist the Dayton Christian Center. They will still accept any remaining labels found on their existing products, but will stop taking all labels next year. The cell phone collection ended several years ago, and there is nobody accepting used ink cartridges for recycling now.

The remaining thing we have recycled are pull tabs from aluminum cans. At the moment, we have nobody to deliver the bags to whoever is collecting them, but if we have a volunteer to handle that item, we can continue collecting the tabs. The various places we have supported over the years have appreciated our help. We can still help with clothing, Box Tops for Education, eyeglasses, and possible pull tabs, but the other items can no longer be recycled.
